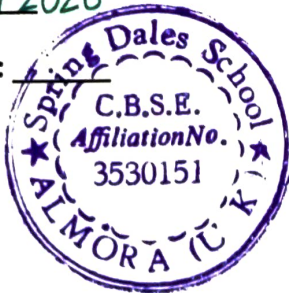

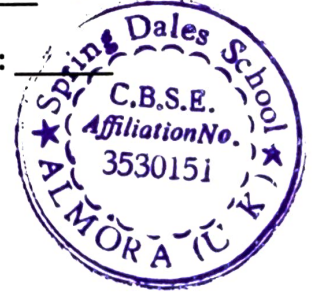

Please Refer; Section 2.4.7 of the CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2018 relates to “Books” prescribed by schools.

The clause states that schools affiliated with CBSE should preferably prescribe NCERT textbooks wherever available and must ensure that any books selected from private publishers do not contain objectionable or inappropriate content.

CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws — Clause 2.4.7 (Books)


(a)The school may prescribe NCERT textbooks in the classes and subjects where these are published by NCERT. Extreme care should be taken while selecting books from private publishers so that:

- \* No objectionable content is included.
- \* No material hurts the sentiments of any class, community, gender, or religious group.

(b) The school must:

- \* Upload the list of prescribed books on the school website.
- \* Provide a written declaration signed by the Principal and Manager stating that they have reviewed the books and take responsibility for the content.

If any objectionable content is found in prescribed books, responsibility lies with the school and CBSE may initiate action against it.
